Call to Order	Mayor D. Pittman called the meeting to order @ 7pm.
Agenda	Motion 2025-20 Stapleton/Cribb Council approved the April 1 agenda as presented. All in Favor. Motion Carried.
Minutes	Motion 2025-21 Cribb/Stapleton Council approved the minutes of the March 4 minutes as presented with no errors or omissions. All in Favor. Motion Carried.
MNL Symposium	The annual MNL Symposium takes place in Gander May 1-3. Council members will let Ginger know if they plan to attend.
Radon Kits	As of March 20 only 10 residents expressed an interest in participating. Council will defer discussion until the next meeting.
Waste Bins the next	Council received information and pricing for waste bins from Brentons. Council will check the status of the ones we have and discuss at meeting.

Budget Letter Council received a letter concerning the Budget 2025 submission. It was stated there are no material deficiencies identified in the completed document.

Blinds **Motion 2025-22** Cribb/Stapleton
Council reviewed the price quoted for new blinds for the town office at \$600 HST included from Canadian Tire. Council agreed to go ahead and purchase the blinds.

Meeting Schedule Council reviewed the information relayed concerning frequency of meeting and decided to leave the motion as previously stated.

New Business Accessibility renovations – Ches asked how the project was going. There was an extension given due to weather and privacy concerns in the office.
Concerns were addressed about 2 family doctors retiring in the next few months. It was asked if there is something we can do as a Municipality by writing a letter to the government. It was agreed there needs to be pressure put on the MHA's. Dave said there is a meeting of the BP Joint Council tomorrow night and he will bring it up.
Dave reported that there will be land cleared on Branch Rd and a water extension may be needed when the house is built. He asked what will be needed to be done. He will check with Dale for details.
