- Call to Order** Mayor D. Pittman called the meeting to order @ 7:10 pm.
- Agenda** **Motion 2023-30** Cribb/Dodge
Council approved the agenda for the May 2 meeting as presented.

Proclamation	Mayor D. Pittman signed the Proclamation of Early Childhood Educator's Week taking place May 28 – June 3.
Tasks complete, put back in the playground entrance	Council will have the maintenance person sweep the Municipal grounds parking lot from the sand from the snow clearing. Once this is complete, the yellow blocks can go back. Benches can now also be put back in the playground area. There is a broken bench by the playground entrance that will have to removed and disposed of.
Floor work have been	Motion 2023-33 Cribb/Stapleton Council agreed to hire Art Hiscock to strip and wax the floors of the meeting room (at a cost of \$200) once the plaster and painting completed. All in Favor. Motion Carried.
Play Structure	Recreation received a new piece of playground equipment. Council discussed how to go about getting it installed. Council will get the maintenance person to look at the instructions and go from there.
Generator delivery	A request for generator quotes was put out to several companies and we are just waiting to hear back. When looking at quotes, ask about details and timeline for delivery.
Early Closure	Council agreed to let the office close @ 4 pm, Friday, May 5 as requested by Ginger.

New Business

Council will get pricing on a bench to be made to be placed in by the airport for the seniors.

Teeter totters can stay in place for now as they are not a safety risk.

We are still waiting to hear back from BPRSB about getting a green bin for the Community Clean up.

There is an old water line sticking from the ground on Pioneer Dr. that needs to be removed.
