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- Summer Student** Council was approved for 1 student laborer position for 30 hours per week for 7 weeks. The position will be advertised with the due date for resumes set for June 4. Council will ask Jody if he is interested in supervising the student this summer. Resumes will be reviewed at the next council meeting.
- Green Dumpster** Council agreed to have the large green bin from the BPRSB for a week in June. They will see what dates are available for a community clean up week.
- Donations** There was an issue with a donation request from a resident whereby the resident was not happy with how things were dealt with. Dora gave an update after speaking with the resident. It was suggested a policy be drawn up with specifics going forward.
- Accessibility Grant** Council agreed to complete the application for an accessibility grant to renovate the entrance ways to make it more accessible to the public. Council will ask Jody to have a look at the area to see what supplies and time would be required so it can be included on the application. The 2 entrances focused on would be the main entrance to the Town Office as well as the main entrance of the recreation centre.
- GIC's** Council discussed what to do with the 2 GIC's that will be maturing in June. Council agreed to leave them as is.
- Issue Update** Ches spoke with MHA Paul Pike on behalf of council to see if there has been any progress with the ongoing issues discussed in the past meeting. Issues discussed were a Crosswalk, speed limit reduction on Kimberley Farm Dr. and funding for a new fridge for the recreation center. Mr. Pike was unable to relay any movement on either of these issues.
- Letter Review** Council reviewed the 2 letters being issued to residents and approved the contents.

Internet **Motion 2024-36** Cribb/Stapleton
Council reviewed the quotes for internet services provided by our current carrier Eastlink. Council agreed to go with the option of adding a business bundle to the recreation center with internet as this will be approximately the same monthly cost.
All in Favor. Motion Carried.

Parking lot Lines Council will see about getting the parking space lines painted at the fire hall as well as the No Parking in front of the 2 garage doors. We will see about getting a stencil and possibly asking our maintenance person to complete this. We will also look at getting quotes.

Tasks Council discussed some tasks for the maintenance person:
Sweep off the parking lot with electric broom
Repair the hydrant pole that is cracked off by Bill Brakes

New Business Community flowers – as discussed in the past, these venture costs a lot to keep up. Council will still order flowers but reduce the number to 18 baskets.
As there won't be as many baskets throughout the community, council will look to see what can be done by the heritage well to spruce that up a bit.
Brush cutting by the water tower is almost complete.
Council will see about getting naloxone kits for the office as well as training for staff.
Town plan update – if no changes are being made to the plan itself, does the town have to pay to have it updated? Council will look into this.
