Policy on the Use of Fire Hydrants

Pursuant to the authority delegated in Section 395 of the Municipalities Act, 1999 the Town of Winterland adopted the following policy on the 8th day of February, 2022.

1. Title

This document shall be known and cited as the *Policy on Use of Fire Hydrants*.

2. Policy Statement

The use of fire hydrants for the purpose of anything other than fire/emergency services is prohibited. All hydrants within the boundaries of Winterland are considered to be town property. Any hydrant use, other than for fire protection, must get approval from council. If council approves a request, access to the hydrant can only be obtained through a local fire fighter using the appropriate tools.


Any person(s) damaging a hydrant as a result of unauthorized use will be responsible for paying all costs of repairs as advised by council.

Any member of the community that is not hooked into the town's water system may use the water spout located on the side of the municipal building.



Policy on Water Connections – New Home Construction

Pursuant to the authority delegated in the Municipalities Act, Chapter M-21, S.N. 1999, the Town of Winterland adopted the following policy on the 8th day of March, 2022

1. Title

This document shall be known and cited as the *Policy on Water Connections – New home Construction*.

2. Regulations

(a) No person, except an authorized employee of the Town shall, open, close, make connection to, nor draw water from or in any way disturb or injure any valve, pipe, curb stop or any other component of the Town's water system.

(b) The work of extending the water service from the curb stop to the premises is the responsibility of the property owner.

(c) When the water line to the premises is complete and fully operable, the water services will be turned on by an employee of the Town.

(d) Property owners requesting new water services to a new build, whereby the connection must cross the road from the main line, will be entitled to be reimbursed by the Town up to a maximum of \$600.

(e) It is the property owner's responsibility to acquire permission from the Department of Transportation to cut across the roadway as they maintain all roads through the Town.

(f) It is the property owner's responsibility to fully cover the cost of repairing the cut in the road.
